Detailed Itinerary

DAY 1 Arrive Cape Town

Arrive at Cape Town International Airport, where you will be met by representative who will assist you to your transfer. You will be met by your driver for your private transfer to the hotel. Upon arrival at the hotel, check in and spend the balance of the day at leisure. Dinner at local India restaurant.

DAY 2 Cape Town City Tour

Breakfast at your hotel. You will be met at your hotel by your driver and guide for a Private Half Day Cape Town City Tour. Ascend Table Mountain for unforgettable sweeping views (weather permitting). Return to the city and pass through the Malay Quarter. Drive past the Castle of Good Hope, Houses of Parliament and the Company Gardens. Travel to Sea Point and Camp's Bay for scenic ocean vistas. Visit the Victoria and Alfred Waterfront. Enjoy some shopping in Cape Town. Cape Town is a shopper's dream with a wide range of shopping expeditions to undertake – from luxury boutiques and shopping malls to private shopping tours and markets, the Mother City has it all. The V & A Waterfront, with over 450 retail outlets selling everything from fashion, home ware and curios to jewellery and tech, is South Africa's most popular shopping destination and offers far more than just shopping. Canal Walk caters to the Northern Suburbs with the Southern Suburbs well served by malls like Cavendish Square and Blue Route Mall. Market shopping is also HUGE in Cape Town with indoor and outdoor markets waiting for you to take advantage of their massive assortment of wares. The best part of market shopping is that many of them are proudly South African or African with Green Market Square arguably the most famous of the 'fixed' markets. Lunch at local India restaurant. Enjoy a scheduled 15 minute 'Hopper' helicopter flight (weather conditions permitting) takes you on a brief bird's eye view of Cape Town. Depart from the V&A Waterfront, fly over the city bowl, Green Point Stadium, Clifton Beach, Camps Bay and The Twelve Apostles and return to the V&A Waterfront over the city.

DAY 3 Cape Peninsula Tour

You will be collected at your hotel by your driver and guide for a Private Full Day Cape Peninsula Tour. Travel at a pace that allows you to explore the beauty of the Cape Peninsula. Depart for the Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve along one of South Africa's most scenic routes, passing Hout Bay. Enjoy a cruise to Seal Island, to view seals and sea birds at Duiker Island (weather permitting). Tours depart at 08h45, 09h45, 11h00, 12h45, 14h45 or 15h45. During summer, several thousand Cape Fur Seals – along with the rare Black Cormorant – lollop leisurely among the kelp beds. Travel along Chapman's Peak Drive (conditions permitting). Visit the penguin colony at Boulders Beach. Continue to the Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve. The scenery en route to Cape Point, at the South Western tip of the reserve, is particularly lovely in spring when wildflowers carpet the landscape. The new lighthouse – the most powerful in the world – beams an electric light of 19 million candle power across the ocean. Ascend to the top of by Funicular. Visit Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens The Treetop Canopy Walkway gives visitors the opportunity to experience the forest from high above the ground. The galvanised steel structure meanders through trees and branches, with sections that crown above the forest.

DAY 4 Hermanus Tour

You will be met by your driver and guide for a private Full day Hermanus Tour. Visit the coastal town of Hermanus. Hermanus is a popular resort town that has gained universal recognition, as the world's best land-based whale watching destination. Hermanus has been a sought-after holiday destination since the early 1800's when it was discovered by an itinerant teacher and shepherd, Hermanus Pieterse. This, he decided, was an ideal place to set up camp, and news of its idyllic setting and legendary champagne-air soon spread: the region was set to become the "Riviera of the South". A mere 140km from the Cape Metropole, Hermanus owes its success to its scenic beauty, mild climate and range of cultural and outdoor attractions. Note: The whale-watching season is from June to November only.

Arrive at Victoria Falls International Airport. You will be met by your driver for your private transfer to the hotel. Upon arrival at the hotel, check in. You will be met by your driver-guide in the hotel reception and depart on your scheduled Sundowner Cruise on the Zambezi River. Guests are met by staff from the Cruise boat and driven to the jetty on the Zambezi River for boarding. The Boat meanders slowly upstream along the length of the National Park looking for game on the way. A number of animals and a host of bird species can be viewed from comfortable chairs on cool wooden decks. Dinner at a local Indian restaurant in the Emperors Palace complex. The sight of elephant, lion, leopard, rhino and buffalo is always a thrill, especially at close range

DAY 10 Victoria Falls

Breakfast at the hotel. You will be met by your driver-guide in the hotel reception and depart on your Seat-in-Coach Tour of the Falls. The Victoria Falls is the largest, probably the most beautiful and certainly the most majestic waterfall anywhere in the world. Return to the hotel in the afternoon and spend some time at leisure. Dinner is served at the hotel.
