## Detailed Itinerary

### DAY 1 Rio De Janeiro

Today we arrive in Rio De Janeiro and are met by our tour representative and are transferred to the hotel. After check in to our hotel rest of the day is free to relax. Late evening, we enjoy our Dinner.

### DAY 2 Rio De Janeiro

After breakfast at the hotel we depart for a half day tour to Corcovado and Tijuca Forest. The Christ the Redeemer Statue is one of the new seven wonders of the planet. The Corcovado ("Hunchback") mountain where it stands, was named for its shape, due to its narrow summit. Building the statue back in 1926 was a big challenge for the engineers. It is the most popular attraction of Corcovado Mountain and brings over 300,000 visitors every year. From the peak's platform, the panoramic view includes downtown Rio, as well as the south area.

### DAY 3 Rio De Janeiro

Today after breakfast we depart to visit city tour of Rio, later we visit the Sugarloaf Mountain. Sugarloaf Mountain is a peak situated in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil, at the mouth of Guanabara Bay on a peninsula that juts out into the Atlantic Ocean. Rising 396 m above the harbor, its name is said to refer to its resemblance to the traditional shape of concentrated refined loaf sugar.

### DAY 4 Rio De Janeiro - Iguazu Falls

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. We later are transferred to the airport to take our flight to Iguazu. On arrival, you will be transferred to the Brazilian side of the falls, best known for all-encompassing vistas of the entire site. From the walkways, you will enjoy panoramic views of Iguazu falls. Altogether, Iguazu Falls stretches an impressive mile across. After your Iguazu tour, you will continue in private transportation to your comfortable hotel on the Argentine side of Iguazu.

### DAY 5 Iguazu Falls - Buenos Aires

Today you will head to the Argentine national park to see the stunning jungle scenery and rushing waterfalls from the Argentine perspective. This side allows up-close views via pathways that hug the falls. You will visit Devils Throat, the largest set of waterfalls in the park. Lunch in the buffet restaurant in the national park. When your tour finishes, you will be taken to the airport for your evening flight to Buenos Aires. On arrival, you will be transferred to your Buenos Aires hotel to rest.

### DAY 6 Buenos Aires

### DAY 7 Buenos Aires - Lima

Later visit the Larco Archaeological Museum, the San Francisco Monastery and its catacombs, Lima's historic colonial squares, and the picturesque waterfront district Miraflores.

### DAY 8 Lima - Cusco

Take a morning flight from coastal Lima to highland Cuzco. After dropping off your suitcases at your hotel San Agustin El Dorado, you will experience first-hand the remnants of this great Incan capital. Your visits to Koricancha Temple and the main cathedral will highlight the differences between Incan and European architecture.

### DAY 9 Sacred Valley Of The Incas

Your Sacred Valley tour will include visits to the ancient circular agricultural terraces of Moray, the salt mines at Maras, and the ruins and village of Ollantaytambo. Departing from Ollantaytambo, enjoy scenic train ride through the Sacred Valley to the town of Machu Picchu where you will stay in your hotel.
