<b>01</b>	<b>Arrive Australia: Melbourne</b> Today we arrive at Melbourne International Airport and are met by your tour representative and are transferred for Lunch and later check into your hotel. Dinner & Overnight at the hotel.	B: No L: Yes D: Yes
<b>02</b>	<b>Melbourne</b> Today after breakfast we depart for the city tour, your first visit would be to the MCG (Melbourne cricket ground) Followed by Lunch. Later we visit the Phillip Island, lies just off Australia's southern coast. At Summerland Beach, spectators gather daily at sunset to watch the Penguin Parade, where little penguins come ashore in groups. The Nobbies outcrop is the viewing site for Seal Rocks, home to a large colony of Australian fur seals. The Phillip Island Circuit is a well-known track for motorcycle and car racing. <b>03</b>	<b>Melbourne – Great Ocean Road</b> Today, after breakfast, we depart for a full-day visit to the Great Ocean Road. The Great Ocean Road is an Australian National Heritage-listed 243-kilometre stretch of road along the southeastern coast of Australia between the Victorian cities of Torquay and Allansford. <b>04</b>	<b>Melbourne – Cairns</b> Today, after breakfast, we are transferred to the airport for our flight to Cairns. On arrival, we are transferred to the Skyrail terminal to Kuranda ( <b>Kuranda Skyrail Caravonica to Kuranda</b> ). The Skyrail Rainforest Cableway experience spans 7.5 km over Australia's pristine tropical rainforests. You'll glide just metres above the rainforest canopy before descending through the canopy layers and deep into the heart of the forest at Skyrail's two rainforest mid-stations for the ultimate tropical rainforest experience. <b>05</b>	<b>Cairns – Big Cat Green Island Cruise</b> Early morning, we depart for Green Island, a beautiful coral cay on Australia's Great Barrier Reef. Green Island is a Marine National Park with unique rainforests, surrounded by white sandy beaches, magnificent coral reefs and abundant marine life. Big Cat "Reef Rocket" is a comfortable catamaran with spacious interior cabins and a relaxed atmosphere. Travel time to Green Island is just over one hour from Cairns. Passengers can take part in the many activities available or simply relax on the beach. The friendly crew will help you organise your activities to make the most of your time on Green Island. <b>07</b>	<p><b>Sydney: Sydney Opera House – Showboat Dinner Cruise</b>            This morning, we proceed for a guided tour of one of the world’s most spectacular landmarks – the Sydney Opera House. Enjoy lunch at the local Indian Restaurant. Tonight, get set for the time of your life on board the Showboat Dinner Cruise. Bordered by hills and the Pacific Ocean, it is situated on the edge of the Canterbury Plains. Upon arrival, we are transferred to visit the International Antarctic Centre. <b>10</b>	<p><b>Christchurch – Franz Josef</b>            This morning, we checked out of the hotel and board the Trans Alpine Express from Christchurch to Greymouth for Arthur’s Pass. From Haast Township, the scenery changes as you pass through small settlements and lakes full of trout and salmon. Later, we depart for Queenstown. <b>12</b>	<p><b>Queenstown – Milford Sound Day Cruise</b>            Today, depart to visit the eighth wonder of the world, Milford Sound, also known as Piopiotahi in Maori. 

<b>13</b>	<p><b>Queenstown</b> Today, after breakfast, we take a scenic ride in the iconic Skyline Gondola and take in the stunning views as we ride the steepest cable car lift in the Southern Hemisphere. Today you have some free time in the city center to explore and do some adventure activities on your own.</p>	<p>B: Yes L: No D: Yes</p>
<b>14</b>	<p><b>Queenstown – Auckland – Rotorua: Agrodome Show</b> After an early breakfast, we will be transferred to the airport for our flight to Auckland and then drive to Rotorua. Departing Auckland, the suburban scenery gradually gives way to farmland, and the mighty Waikato River will accompany you for much of the journey through the green countryside. At Fitzgerald Glade, the lush ferns and pretty tree canopy signal the approach to Rotorua. A geothermal hot spot, Rotorua is full of steaming vents, spouting geysers and bubbling mud pools. The city is surrounded by mountains, rivers, forests and freshwater lakes, with natural hot springs perfect for bathing and relaxing. Rotorua is the heartland of Maori culture and an ideal place to experience the traditional customs of New Zealand’s indigenous people.</p> <p><b>Arrive in Rotorua.</b> The moment of arrival in Rotorua is somehow quite different. There is a scent of sulphur in the air. At the nearby geothermal hotspots, there are spouting geysers, mud pools bubbling and warm geothermal pools and ponds that create a kaleidoscope of color. Rotorua is also the heartland of New Zealand's Maoridom, and the warm spirit of this living culture will captivate and enthrall.</p>	<p>B: Yes L: No D: Yes</p>
<b>15</b>	<p><b>Rotorua: Waitomo Glow Worm Cave – Auckland</b> After breakfast, we visit the <b>Agrodome for a New Zealand farm show featuring sheep dog demonstrations</b>, cow milking and an introduction to the stars of our sheep industry. Later, we drive to visit the Waitomo / <b>Rotorua Inc Glow-worm Caves</b>. Travel through the horticultural farmland and into the lush dairy farm areas. After this, continue through the ever-changing scenery, driving around Hamilton, the Bridge City, onto the Waitomo region, where we stop at today’s highlight: your guided tour through the famous <b>Waitomo Glow-worm Caves</b>, which have spectacular limestone formations and the roof is studded with the lights of thousands of tiny Glow-worms. Later, depart for Auckland by coach. On arrival, enjoy an orientation tour of Auckland with an Indian lunch. <b>16</b>	<p><b>Auckland: Sightseeing Inc Kelly Tarlton’s</b> Today, we visit Kelly Tarlton's Antarctic Encounter. Then it is back to the present, into the special Antarctic enclosure where you will see King and Gentoo Penguins closer than ever before.
